Ordinance # 3

The town of Remington does hereby ordain: "That it is illegal to park or leave any unlicensed or unused vehicle on any street in the Town of Remington, Wood County, Wisconsin, at any time. Provision One and Two apply.

Provision One: Any person who shall violate any provision of this ordinance shall upon conviction therefore, forfeit not less than \$10 or more than \$200 together with cost of prosecution and in default of payment of such forfeiture and costs shall be imprisoned in the County Jail until said forfeiture and costs are paid but not exceeding ninety (90) Days.

Provision Number Two: This Ordinance was adopted on December 14, 1987 and then amended on January 11, 1988 by the Town Board and will go into effect after publication.
