ORDINANCE # 4

The Town Board of the Town of Remington, Wood County, Wisconsin does ordain the following, that it is illegal to leave any foreign matter on streets, alleys, sidewalks or other town property. Foreign matter being defined as but not limited to, objects which could obstruct traffic and litter as defined in the State Statute 80.65 Waste on Highways.

Provision One: Any person who shall violate any provision of this Ordinance shall upon conviction thereof, forfeit not less than Ten (\$10) Dollars nor more than Two Hundred (\$200) Dollars together with the costs of prosecution and in default of payment of such forfeiture and costs shall be imprisoned in the County Jail until said forfeiture and costs are paid, but not exceeding ninety (90) days.

Provision Two: This ordinance was adopted on September 5, 1973 and then amended on March 14, 1988.
