Ordinance # 5

The Town Board of Remington does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. The purpose of this ordinance is to designate routes within the Town of Remington for snowmobile operation is lawful, but for the purpose of providing access to and from designated trails and not for general operation of snowmobiles upon said routes, all under the authority of S. 350.04 (2), Wisconsin Stats.

Section 2. The routes designated as lawful routes in the Town of Remington all those provided in the resolution of November 13, 1975. Operation of a snowmobile on any road other than prescribed routes are declared unlawful.

Section 3. All snowmobile operation hereunder shall be on the extreme right side of the roadway and all left turns shall be made as safely as possible from any position depending on snow cover and the prevailing conditions.

Section 4. Snowmobile operators shall yield right of way to other vehicular traffic and pedestrians.

Section 5. The Town of Remington shall mark the prescribed routes in accordance with S. 350.13 Wisconsin Stats.

Section 6. No snowmobile operation is permitted on state trunk highways as provided under S. 350.02 Wisconsin Stats.

Section 7. Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, forfeit not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$50.00 for each offense, together with the cost of prosecution, and in default of payment of such forfeiture and costs shall be imprisoned in the County Jail of Wood County until same are paid, not to exceed thirty days, by Wood County District Attorney.

Section 8. This ordinance shall be effective upon passage and publication as provided by law.
